Upon review of the Nation's current financial status, it was determined by Chief & Council of the We Wai Kai Nation that we are in a position to offer distribution to all registered membership this year.

Given the combination of the ongoing pandemic crisis, yet another poor fishing season and members in the forestry industry who are continuing to struggle as well, Chief & Council has decided that they would like to support members that are currently struggling and offer a small one-time distribution of **\$500.00** to our current membership registered as of December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.

The administration office will be preparing cheques for all **REGISTERED CAPE MUDGE BAND MEMBERS** this week. Cheques will be available for pick up at the Quinsam Hall on Friday, December 11<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9am, 2020, after which time they will be available for pickup at the Quinsam Administration Office from December 14<sup>th</sup> through December 18<sup>th</sup>. Any cheques not picked up by December 18<sup>th</sup> will automatically be placed in the mail. Cheques will also be mailed during this time to members off-reserve at the last known address.

PLEASE NOTE: Anyone picking up a cheque will be required to adhere to Dr. Bonnie Henry's Covid-19 protocols and must wear a mask. In addition, photo ID will be required.

Chief & Council understand that administration may not have current addresses for all members and so members will have 90 days from December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to contact the office with a current address.
